

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS:

IUPAP Young Scientist (Early Career) Prizes in Fundamental Metrology

Deadline for nominations: 31 March 2010

Nominations are sought for the IUPAP Young Scientist Prize in Fundamental Metrology. Up to two prizes are to be awarded in 2010 by the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics through Commission C2 (Symbols, Units, Nomenclature, Atomic Masses and Fundamental Constants - <http://www.iupap.org/commissions/c2/mandate.html>).

The prize will be awarded during the 2010 Conference on Precision Electromagnetic Measurements (CPEM 2010) to be held in Daejeon, Korea, 13 – 18 June 2010. The Prize comprises a medal and an award of 1,000 Euro.

The nominee is expected to have made original and outstanding contributions to the field of fundamental metrology. The leading personal contribution of the recipient to the achievement must be clearly identifiable when the work was performed in collaboration. Nominees for the prize should have a maximum of 8 years of research experience (excluding career interruption) following the PhD on January 1, 2010.

The winner or winners of the prize will be chosen by the members of Commission C2 - <http://www.iupap.org/commissions/c2/members.html> .

The prize-winner(s) will be notified by 30 April 2010.

Nominations must include:

- A letter of not more than 1,000 words evaluating the nominee's achievements and identifying the specific work to be recognized.
- A curriculum vitae including all publications.
- A brief biographical sketch not exceeding two pages.

Self-nominations will not be considered.
